Extra Breast Pads & Spare Shirt in case of leaks!
Cooler with Ice Pack(s)
Safely transport your liquid gold home with you.
Nipple Cream
Apply before and after you pump to help relieve any sensitivity.
Gallon Storage Bag or Wet/Dry Bag
Place pump parts that touch milk into a gallon zip storage bag or wet/dry bag and store the bag into the refrigerator. The milk on the parts stays fresh in the fridge, so there's not stay and store in the fridge.
